This policy is supplemental to Te Kawa Maiorooro, Te Pūkenga Educational Regulatory Framework.

Te Kawa Maiorooro sets out the overarching regulations that apply to learning and delivery (teaching, assessment, rangahau and research, and support activities) at Te Pūkenga. As and when finalised, Te Pūkenga will publish policies and procedures that are intended to sit underneath Te Kawa Maiorooro and prescribe detailed requirements.

In the meantime, pursuant to Te Pūkenga Grandparenting Policy, the regulations, policies, and procedures of the former subsidiaries apply unless there is a national regulation or policy in place. Accordingly, where a specific matter is not addressed within Te Kawa Maiorooro, this policy is intended to prescribe the requirements that are specific to the NMIT business division.

To the extent that there is any conflict or inconsistency between any of NMIT's policies or procedures and Te Kawa Maiorooro, Te Kawa Maiorooro shall prevail and have priority.

COURSE RESULT KEYS

INTRODUCTION

The Course Result Key lists the results available for a course, and the description of what each result represents. The Result Key is specified in the Programme Regulations. Generally the same Result Key applies to all the courses in a programme, but in some cases the Result Key may differ between the courses in the same programme.

Each Course Result Key has an identification code made up of three components:

- 1. Type of assessment being used:
 - CO = Competency Based Assessment
 - AC = Achievement Based Assessment
- 2. Letters identifying the organisation that the Course Result Key originates from:
 - ARA = Ara Institute of Canterbury
 - NMIT = Nelson Marlborough Institute of Technology
 - NZDE = New Zealand Board for Engineering Diplomas
 - NZQA = NZ Qualifications Authority
 - o TANZ = eCampus New Zealand previously Tertiary Accord of New Zealand
 - TPK = Te Pūkenga (for unified programmes)
 - UCOL = University College of Learning
 - WINT = WINTEC (Waikato Institute of Technology)
- **3. Two-digit number** starting at 01 indicating which of the Result Keys from that organisation is being used.

Example: CO-NMIT-01 = Competency Based assessment, NMIT Result Key, number 1
