## Convictions Against the Law

When students apply to the NMIT Health Programmes, they are required to make a declaration about whether they have ever been convicted of any offence against the law. It is programme policy to alert the applicant to this requirement. This information is sought so that potential problems regarding their employment may be discussed with applicants before their application is processed.

If you are accepted onto the Certificate in Nursing (Competence Assessment Programme) course, you must also complete and return a Ministry of Justice Criminal Records form, which will be sent to you in your Confirmation Pack.
