"A training scheme is defined in section 159 of the Education Act 1989 as study and training that leads to an award but does not, of itself, lead to a qualification listed on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF)." - [NZQA.govt.nz](https://www.nzqa.govt.nz)
