Can I extend my library loans / renew my books?

You can renew your borrowed items once. The renewal period is for the same time as the initial loan period, i.e. a 3-week item will renew for another 3 weeks, a 3-day item will renew for another 3 days. You will not be able to renew an item if someone has placed a reservation on it, or if it is overdue*. You can renew items yourself, up until the day *before* any item is due, by signing into your library account via the library [Catalogue/My Library](#). To renew items which are already overdue* either phone the library (03 5395068) or visit us in person.

*Items that are overdue by 3 days or less can be renewed as long as there are no current reservations on those items. 3- Day Loan items can only be renewed if they are no more than one day overdue and as long as there are no current reservations on those items.
