If you want to withdraw from a course or programme once it has started, you will need to contact your programme area for a Withdrawal/Refund Application form.

You'll need to complete and sign the Withdrawal/Refund Application form and submit it to the Head of Department for consideration.

If you are receiving a student loan or student allowance, you must notify StudyLink yourself.

An administration fee may be charged for each withdrawal.
