How can I pay for my short course?

Your place on the course is not secured until your payment has been received in full and your <u>identification has been provided</u>. Please pay and provide ID within 3 days. NMIT will email you two reminders. If you do not supply payment or ID after these reminders (10 days), you will be withdrawn from this course.

Places on short courses will be filled as payment and identification is received, this may result in a course becoming full during the period that you have not paid or provided identification, please accept our apologies if this occurs. We will contact you to offer you a place on an upcoming course or ask if you would like a full refund.
