Nelson Campus

Individual and group study rooms are available to book in the Library Learning Centre, M Block. Please use the bookings folder available on Level 1 (Ground floor). \bar{A} konga are also welcome to study in any available classrooms; check the printed timetable outside rooms for availability.

Marlborough Campus

Ask at the main reception, A Block, if there are any free classrooms available for study.

Richmond Campus

The main study area is in the Student Centre (B Block). Meeting rooms in A Block (for quiet study or for groups of up to 6) or classrooms (for groups of 7 or more) can be used by ākonga if they are available. To check availability and make bookings, ask at the Richmond campus reception (A Block).
