You can purchase a new bike from a bike shop, or purchase a secondhand bike through an auction website such as [Trade Me](#) or [Facebook Marketplace](#).

Motorcycles and Mopeds are registered with the New Zealand Transport Agency and will require annual registration and a change of ownership notification the same as for [buying or selling a car](#). You will also require a drivers licence to ride these, [find out more here](#).

[Low powered Electric scooters or e-scooters](#) do not require registration or a drivers licence.
