It is important to check that your visa allows you to study one of our short courses. You should contact Immigration New Zealand if you require clarification.

If your visa allows you to study one of our short courses, you must have valid insurance during the study period. The minimum insurance cost is \$50.00 for one month. If you have your own insurance policy, please provide NMIT with a copy of your policy to seek approval. Your insurance policy must be approved by NMIT's insurance company before the insurance fee can be waived.
