Travel items

- Travel documents
- Passport and visa letter/label
- Medical and travel insurance documents (only if you have organised your own insurance)

Academic paperwork

- NMIT Offer and Receipt Documents
- Academic records (or certified copies)

Personal items

- Driver licence, if you have one (Must be in English)
- New Zealand uses a different type of electrical plug compared to other parts of the world. Electricity in New Zealand is supplied at a minimal voltage of 230-240 volts and 50 hertz.
