Devices range from a few years old to brand new, some may have touch screens, but all will come with wifi, webcam and Windows 10.

The devices come setup like a computer you'd buy from a retail store and are capable of running software from your NMIT Microsoft (Office) 365 online account, which also enables you to download full versions of that software to the device for free. You can also install any software or apps you want so long as legal to do so.

Remember to save any files you create in the cloud e.g. in Microsoft OneDrive, so you don't lose them if the laptop has a problem or when you have to return it at the end of your studies.
