[Hauora Health Centre](#) appointments for International Students who have [Studentsafe Insurance](#), are generally free of charges. Before your first visit, you need to [complete a registration form](#) and present your current student card, passport and a copy of your student visa. Note that costs may be payable for any preexisting conditions not covered by your insurer.

[Book an appointment online](#), call 03 548 8663 or email reception@hauorahealth.nz. The centre is located about 5 minutes away from Nelson Campus at 105 Collingwood Street.

Note: if you don't attend your appointment, you may be charged a fee. Please remember to advise the service in advance if you are not intending to attend.
